Courses

-  Metal Inert Gas Welding (MIG) 10 days
-  Flux Cored Arc Welding (FCAW) 10 days
-  Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (GTAW) Stainless Steel – 10 days
-  Oxy-Acetylene Welding and Brazing
-  Aluminium Welding

On completion of the GTAW and SMAW courses, learners are given the option of welding to FABRICON code and having their test piece sent for non-destructive testing (NDT) whereupon an **ASME IX** certification would be issued by a unit of inspection with SABS Accreditation and International Status. Learners are also issued with free personal protective equipment (PPE) except for boots.

In addition to the above, the following courses are also rendered:

-  Coding of welders
-  Warm ups
-  Trade Test Preparations
-  Welding Theory lessons (N2 Equivalent)
